X Window System Features

Same file format: Corel WordPerfect 8 for Linux – Server Edition has a rich file format that does not need updating with each application revision. To ensure compatibility, Corel WordPerfect 8 for Linux – Server Edition will have no file format change from versions 6, 6.1, 7, and 8.

Cross-platform compatibility: The same file format is shared between Windows® 95, Windows NT®, Windows 3.1x, and UNIX.

Enhanced file management Corel WordPerfect 8 for Linux – Server Edition lets manage over 40 different file formats, including Microsoft® Word 97 files.

File Manager: The File Manager lets users access files, create directories, and change file modes without having to remember Linux commands.

Shadow Cursor: When users point to text or white space, the insertion point changes to a Shadow Cursor. When the Shadow Cursor appears in the white space of a document, users can click anywhere to start typing text. Users can also insert clipart, text boxes, or tables using the Shadow Cursor. The Shadow Cursor eliminates the need to insert blank lines manually in order to leave blank lines between paragraphs or graphics. The Shadow Cursor changes appearance to show how the text will be aligned when users start typing. The arrows on the Shadow Cursor point in different directions, depending on whether the text is left justified, centered, or right justified.

Spell-As-You-Go™: Spell-As-You-Go™ marks words that might be misspelled so that users can correct them if necessary. Spell-As-You-Go is turned on automatically when users start Corel WordPerfect 8 for Linux – Server Edition. Alternative word choices are also displayed in a box on the Property Bar. If the word is misspelled, users can select the correctly spelled word from this list.

Grammar-As-You-Go™: Grammar-As-You-Go™ let users recognize and fix common grammar problems as they type. Users can right-click marked phrases and choose a correct phrase from a list of suggestions.

Property Bar: The Property Bar provides easy access to some of the most frequently used editing and text layout features. The Property Bar remains in the same position on screen, but the contents change depending on what users select. Users can customize the Property Bar by adding items they use most often and deleting those items they do not use.

Drawing Layer: The Drawing Layer lets users draw directly on top of text. Users can create lines and shapes, as well as add color, gradient fills, and patterns to graphics and boxes in their documents.

HTML forms: Users can add form fields to a Web document using the Internet Publisher. HTML form fields include radio buttons, check boxes, selection lists, and text boxes. HTML forms let users gather valuable information quickly and easily.

PerfectExpert™: PerfectExpert™ helps users complete projects with step-by-step guidance and shows users quick and easy ways to complete common tasks.

Table enhancements: Users can easily size, join, or split rows within a table by dragging.
